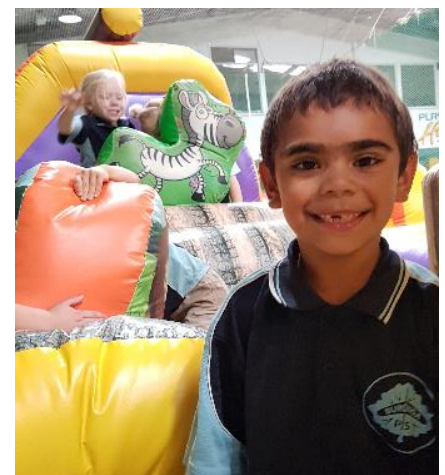


Disco
